

**Information clause and consent form for personal data processing in MediWell Beauty Dr Marta Skoczylas**

In accordance with Article 13(1) and (2) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data of natural persons, I inform you that the Administrator of your personal data processed at the MediWell Beauty practice, Dr Marta Skoczylas ul. Kamionkowska 41/3, 03-812 Warsaw is Dr Marta Skoczylas, M.D..

The controller processes your personal data pursuant to Article 6(1)(a), (b), (c) and (e) and Article 9(2)(b) and (h) of the Regulation. Your personal data shall be processed in order to provide health services aimed at preserving, saving, restoring or improving your health, carry out procedures in the field of aesthetic medicine, as well as other medical activities resulting from the treatment process or separate provisions regulating their performance. Your personal data will be processed pursuant to Article 9(2)(h). RODO, in connection with the applicable laws.

We will collect and process photos of lesions, dermoscopic images, photos capturing the image of the patient for documentation purposes. Providing this data is mandatory and results from the provisions of the law, failure to provide the data will result in the inability to keep records related to the provision of health services, performance of procedures in the field of aesthetic medicine, which, in turn, may lead to a lack of health services, performance of procedures on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of RODO, and on the basis of consent under Article 9(2)(a) of RODO, only for the purpose specified in the content of the consent.

Your personal data shall be made available to other entities or bodies authorised by law, on the basis of data entrustment agreements, to persons authorised by the patient to obtain medical documentation. The National Health Fund, other entities providing health services, if the data are necessary to ensure the continuity of health services

Your personal data shall be made available to IT systems providers, owners of the "MedFile" "app:medfile.pl" Internet platform and software used for registering patients and maintaining patients' medical records, entities providing legal services, entities providing medical archiving services.

Your personal data is made available to Entities in connection with the implementation of obligations under the law, in particular health care law. Entities authorized on the basis of: administrative decisions, court decisions, executive titles. State authorities, or bodies of local self-government in connection with the conduct of proceedings.
